4. Who else joins Paul in Corinth and how does this affect his preaching of the gospel?
5. How successful is Paul at preaching the gospel to the Jews in Corinth and how does he respond to their rejection?
6. Explain the phrase “your blood be upon your own heads.”
7. Who is Crispus and why is he significant?
8. What do we learn about the Apostle Paul from the vision he receives at Corinth?

9. Who is Gallio and why is Paul brought before him?
10. How does Gallio respond to the accusations about Paul?
11. How does Paul's time in Corinth end?
12. Chronicle how Paul's second missionary journey ends.

Applying the Text

- What keys about persuading people to obey the gospel are revealed in the events at Corinth?
- What applications should we make from the statement in Acts 18:6 where Paul said "Your blood be upon your own heads! I am clear of my responsibility"?
- What discourages you or makes you afraid about teaching the gospel?
- Why do you think the Holy Spirit, writing through Luke, leaves us the account of Paul before Gallio?
